

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE LEGACY CHARITY GOLF DAY HELD AT HUNTINGDALE GOLF CLUB

Friday 24 January 2014

1. Each participant/company must complete an entry form and return it with full payment to secure entry to either the Morning or Afternoon events. The fee must be paid by cash, credit card or cheque - all cheques payable to Melbourne Legacy.
2. Sponsorship entitles the company to two spots in the field AM or PM plus naming rights to one prominent tee all day (must use own banners/promotional material in accordance with the guidelines as set out by Huntingdale Golf Club).
3. Clubs are invited to enter a team of 4 members (but 3 will be accepted if necessary) to compete for the Legacy at Huntingdale Perpetual Trophy in a Club Competition. The Club Trophy will be awarded to the team with the highest aggregate of the best 3 scores.

5. Each grade is to have a minimum number of 20 participants. If this is not reached, entrants will be combined with other grades which may include AM and PM fields if necessary.
6. Information regarding events may be obtained from Melbourne Legacy on 8626 0500.
7. Entries of amateurs are restricted to Amateurs who are Members of Clubs of the Victorian Golf Association, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Association as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, or of Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League or Clubs affiliated with or recognised by Women's Golf Victoria. Players must have a recognised handicap. The Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
8. Entries of professionals are restricted to professionals affiliated with the PGA of Australia, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
9. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are approved by the VGA and are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the competition whose decision shall be final. Provided however, that the Committee if in doubt, shall have the right to refer any such dispute to the Council of the Victorian Golf Association, whose decision shall be final.
10. Competitors shall be appointed Honorary Members for the day.
11. Huntingdale Golf Club has a Non-Metal Spike policy. No competitor will be permitted to play with metal spikes. Golf shoes with approved non-metal spikes must be worn and denim clothing is not permitted at any time. Refunds will not be given for non compliance with these conditions.
12. Mobile telephones are banned on the golf course and in the clubhouse.
13. Refunds will not be given unless fourteen (14) days written notice is given prior to the commencement of the tournament.
14. Players must exercise extreme caution when playing a shot such that the players in front are out of range. A loud call of 'FORE' must accompany any errant shot that could put another person/player at risk.
